# ARE YOU READY?

**All Research with animals in RC1 must end by March 31, 2010.**

**Mice from RC1 are NOT permitted to enter R2 or RC1 after closure for decontamination.**

**Mice can only enter clean facilities from these sources**

- Standard Vendors
- Embryo rederivation
- Non-routine source Quarantine

**Only mice, rats, gerbils, and fish can be housed in R2. Studies with all other animals must be suspended during the decontamination**

**There are no imaging or ABSL capabilities in R2. Limited procedural areas for behavior**
