- Cardboard & Paperboard
- Plastics # 1 - 7
- Office Paper
- Magazines & Newspaper
- Phone Books
- Junk Mail
- Brown Paper Bags
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Aluminum Cans & Foil, Pie Tins
- Steel Cans & Empty Aerosol Cans
