



**Liquor Law violations, drug abuse violations and weapons possession violations** categories for 2004 include persons arrested and/or detained at the University of Colorado Hospital (UCH) Emergency Department, a public health care facility. This area is a controlled access area and persons and packages are subject to metal detectors and /or physical search for weapons. Weapons discovered have included, but are not limited to, knives, brass knuckles and handguns. Drug abuse violations occur when drug paraphernalia and/or marijuana or other drugs are discovered. Not all parties are charged with criminal offenses in these cases.

There were no **referrals for disciplinary action or judicial referral** for any liquor law violations, drug law violations or illegal weapons possessions for 2004, 2005 or 2006.

There were no **HATE CRIMES** reported in 2004, 2005 or 2006 in any of the previously listed categories, on this campus.

There are **NO residence halls** on this University of Colorado at Denver and Health Sciences Center (UCDHSC) Campus. Thus, there is no category for "Residence Hall Crimes" included in this report.

The 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue & Colorado Boulevard campus of the UCDHSC is located within the City and County of Denver.
