There were no **referrals for disciplinary action or judicial referral** for any liquor law violations, drug law violations or illegal weapons possessions on this campus for 2008, 2009 or 2010.

There were no **HATE CRIMES** reported in 2008, 2009 or 2010 in any of the previously listed categories or in any other crime category, where injury occurred.

There are **NO residence halls** on the University of Colorado Denver (UCD) Anschutz Medical Campus (AMC). Thus, there is no category for "Residence Hall Crimes" included in this report.

* The 2009 Aggravated Assaults involved the use of cutting instruments in a threatening manner. There were no injuries. The suspect in one incident was arrested and criminally charged. In the other incident, the case was dismissed by the DA.

The decrease in the number of burglaries in 2009 can be attributed to a change in the definitions of burglary and theft as outlined by the FBI.

** In three of the 2009 Motor Vehicle Thefts, suspects were identified and arrested.

*** The 2 aggravated assaults occurred when an armed party attempted to assault and elude police officers.

**** The 5, 2009 reported forcible sex offenses occurred at a medical clinic, were classified as unwanted sexual contact and were not substantiated or prosecuted. However, the crimes could not be "unfounded." **All allegations are attributable to one individual who is no longer an employee at the University.**
