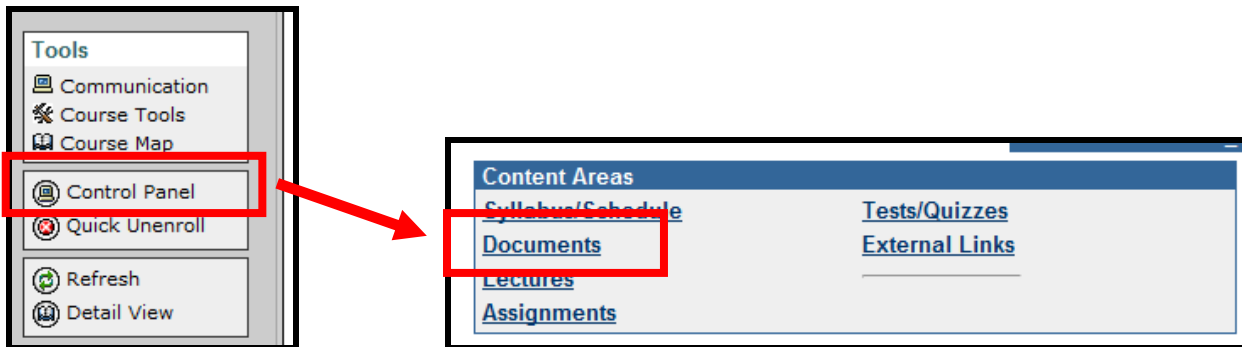


Embedding a YouTube Video

As more videos become readily available on the internet, faculty and students often find it useful to be able to access it via their online course. This jobaid demonstrates how you can embed a YouTube video into your course.

Step 1

Login to your course and select the course menu where you wish to place the embedded video for access. For this example, I will select **Control Panel**, then **Documents**.



Step 2


From within Documents, select **Add Item**.



Step 3

Fill in the details on the content item you wish to add. Next click on the < > **Toggle HTML Source Mode** so you are now in the html view.

NOTE: If you do not see the below icons, you need to expand on the arrows towards the left side of the visual text editor













Click on the arrows to expand the visual text editor

Step 4

Next, go to **YouTube** (www.youtube.com) and locate the video you wish to embed.

Step 5

You will notice the Embed code for the video right under URL. First select the options for the video (ie border, enable privacy mode, color, dimensions). Once you have done this, copy the embed code by highlighting into the box.
