**Designers Without Boundaries**

The mission of the College of Architecture and Planning *Designers Without Boundaries* (DWB) program is to enrich the academic experience of first-generation and historically-underrepresented students and provide opportunities for students to interact and build community in meaningful ways that promote a collaborative, cooperative and supportive environment. *Designers Without Boundaries* believes that an effective academic service program will improve retention, increase civic engagement and graduate successful students into the design professions of architecture, planning and urban design, and landscape architecture.

**Description of Scholarship**

The College of Architecture and Planning will be awarding a limited number of participation grants to motivated, high-achieving, and diverse students who are interested in a career in architecture, planning and urban design, and landscape architecture. The scholarship awards are \$1,500 per academic year and can vary in term from one to four years. Grant recipients will be required to participate in DWB events and activities in the College of Architecture and Planning. Recipients must maintain good academic standing with at least a 3.0 GPA and are also required to participate in community service activities outside of the College. Academics and participation are an important and required role of this scholarship.

Unfortunately, international students are not eligible.
