Foreign Language

Required of CAM undergraduates with majors in the Department of Visual Arts or the Department of Theatre, Film and Video Production. Undergraduates in the Department of Music & Entertainment Industry Studies are exempt from this requirement.

- ◆ Second college semester proficiency in a single foreign language
- ◆ 0-10 credit hours
- ◆ Demonstrated by **one** of the following:
 - Completion of a 2nd year (Level II) high school course with a minimum grade of C-/1.7 in the final semester
 - 2nd semester (Level II) college-level course with minimum grade of C-/1.7. May not be taken pass/fail. A “conversation” course is not acceptable.
 - Satisfactory proficiency test. Contact the UC Denver Department of Modern Languages at 303-556-4893 for details.

Non-major arts

All CAM undergraduates must complete at least **one** course in the “arts” outside of their major area. Specifically:

Music majors must take three credits in Theatre/Film and/or Visual Arts

Visual Arts majors must take three credits in Music and/or Theatre/Film

Theatre/Film majors must take three credits in Visual Arts and/or Music

- ◆ 3 credit hours total
- ◆ Must earn passing grade(s) (D-/1.7 or higher)
- ◆ Students may mix and match disciplines to reach 3 credits, or they may take a 3-credit course from one discipline.

General Electives

CAM undergraduates may need to complete general elective courses to meet minimum credit requirements for their degrees. Please consult a CAM academic advisor for details.
