



POSTER PRESENTATIONS APPLICATION FORM

The Colorado School of Public Health's Center for Global Health and School of Medicine, Division of Infectious Diseases AIDS Education and Training Center are soliciting poster submissions for the 3rd Annual Global Health Symposium: "HIV/AIDS at Home and Abroad". The purpose of the poster presentations is to encourage information exchange about programs, research or other projects related to global health. Posters will be arranged as an exhibit area, so attendees can walk by and stop to discuss those of interest. All accepted abstracts will be presented as posters at the 3rd Annual Global Health Symposium hosted by Center for Global Health, Colorado School of Public Health and the AIDS Education and Training Center, School of Medicine Division of Infectious Diseases on October 15, 2010 from 3:15 to 4:30 pm.

Eligibility:

We are looking for students and professionals to present posters. The topic of HIV/AIDS will be given priority but other global health topics will be considered. Students and professionals are encouraged to submit abstracts for work they have either completed or are in process of completing. We are striving to have a wide variety of departments, schools and organizations represented. Joint presentations across disciplines and organizations are also encouraged.

Poster Guidelines:

A poster session is also a graphic presentation of authors' reports. The authors illustrate their findings by displaying graphs, photos, diagrams and a small amount of text on the poster. The authors will then hold discussions with the registrants who are circulating among the posters. The author must remain by his/her poster board for the duration of the poster session. If handouts are distributed, please keep them to a minimum. Be sure to highlight the authors' names and address information in case the viewer is interested in contacting them for more information. It is expected that all accepted poster presenters will register for the symposium; October 15th.

The poster should be no more than 3 feet tall by 5 feet wide. Materials should include the title of the presentation and list of authors. Letters in the title should be at least 1 inch high. Bring all illustrations needed—figures, tables, color photographs, charts. The material should be well labeled and legible from a distance of two yards. If you are posting typed material, use a large font size (20 to 24 fonts).

Deadlines:
