

TIMELINE FOR UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION URBAN COMMUNITY TEACHER EDUCATION

Undergraduate Licensure Program Major Pathways

Elementary (K-6)
Individually Structured Major
(courses in Math, Science, English, & History)

MAJORS

Secondary (7-12) English, Social Studies (History or Political Science), Math, Science (ISM), Foreign Language (French and Spanish)

During your Freshman, Sophomore, Junior year:

- Work on the UCD Core and CLAS Graduation Requirements. Have all courses completed by the end of your Junior year
- Meet with your CLAS advisor each semester, secondary students meet with major faculty advisor also
- Join Students for Equity and Justice in Education (SEJE) to gain experience working with urban youth, urbanteacher@ucdenver.edu
- Follow the flow chart below for Admissions and Teacher Education courses (UEDU)

TCED 1111: 1st Year Seminar
Counts towards Humanities Core
Complete Fall of Freshman yr

- **UEDU 4010:** Foundations of Social Justice & Equity
- **UEDU 4020:** Classroom Communities
- **UEDU 4930:** Early Internship and Seminar

Must take in the above order. 4020 and 4930 are recommended to take concurrently. These courses should be taken during sophomore and early junior year. All UCTE courses must be B or better.

During your Senior Year:

- Full-time UCTE Program - 2 semesters
- Complete your UCTE Classes
- Maintain at least 2.75 cumulative GPA
- All UEDU courses must be B or better

FRESHMAN

Initial UCTE Admission

Deadlines: October 15 & March 15

- Minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA
- One unofficial transcript from colleges and universities attended
- Oath and Consent Form
- Fingerprint Affidavit (including a \$39.50 processing fee)
- 1 Recommendation Form from UCD Faculty
- Essay (2 pgs): Teacher Manifesto

Full UCTE Admissions (Junior Year)

Admission Deadlines:

In order to graduate in May, you must apply for admissions by January or February 15th.

In order to graduate in December, you must apply for admissions by August 15th.

- CLAS Advising Sheet
- Minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA
- Two official transcripts from universities/colleges attended
- Fingerprint Affidavit
- Oath and Consent Form
- Resume
- 2 Recommendations:
 - Recommendation Form from UEDU Instructor
 - Recommendation Form from Major Faculty
- 2 Evaluations:
 - Evaluation from 4930 Site Professor
 - Evaluation form from Clinical Teacher
- 3 Essays:
 - Experience working with youth
 - Why I want to be an Urban Teacher
 - Updated "Teacher Manifesto" essay
- Place or Praxis II, scores required by interview
- Admissions interview

Graduation/Licensure:

- Apply for graduation after you register for your last semester
- Apply for licensure through CDE when your classes are complete and grades are posted
