The 2011 Rocky Mountain TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) Institute is a great opportunity for both public school teachers wishing to develop their skills and for those pursuing training to teach ESL/EFL in the US or abroad, especially to adults or young adults. Course participants interact with graduate students, teachers from Colorado and abroad, and post-secondary international students who are studying English.

Classes meet on downtown Denver's Auraria Campus. All classes are 3 graduate-level semester credits and include hands-on activities in Spring International's adult intensive English classes. All courses may be used at the University of Colorado Denver to partially fulfill the requirements for a TESOL Certificate, the Colorado Department of Education Linguistically Diverse Educator Endorsement, and/or the master's degree in Curriculum and Instruction (Linguistically Diverse Education emphasis). Students from other programs and universities are also welcome.
