

H. PETER CHASE, MD is the past Executive and Clinical Director of the Barbara Davis Center for Childhood Diabetes in Denver, CO. In addition, he is a Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center in Aurora, CO.

Dr. Chase received his education at the University of Wisconsin in Madison, WI. He completed his internship and residency at the University of Utah and Stanford University. A fellowship in Endocrinology and metabolism (Stanford and the University of Colorado) was followed by research at the National Institute of Health. He has since been a faculty member of the University of Colorado. He is a principal investigator in the multi-center NIH – funded studies of Diabetes Research in Children Network (DIRECNET) and the Type 1 Diabetes/TrialNet prevention studies.

Dr. Chase has received many honors, including the Outstanding Physician Clinician in Diabetes award from the American Diabetes Association, a Lifetime Achievement Award from JDRF and the Ross Award for Outstanding Research in Pediatrics. He has authored over 200 research papers and 50 textbook chapters. In addition to this synopsis “First Book”, the larger 11th Edition of “Understanding Diabetes” follows the same outline of chapters.
