WHO: A minimum of THREE (3) students from at least TWO (2) different health professions on the Anschutz Medical Campus.

WHAT: Author a short case scenario of an ethical issue that might be faced in the health professions. This first competition is inspired by the Deadly Medicine exhibit at the Fulginiti, on display through May 22nd, and the case should explore an ethical topic related to lessons learned from the legacy of health professionals' voluntary involvement in the WWII Genocides / Holocaust.

WHY: Cases will be selected by an interprofessional panel of students and faculty members from across campus. The winning case will be evaluated for possible use during the spring 2019 Interprofessional Education and Development (IPED) course.
