### Department Activities

The Department of Pediatrics placed fifth in the 2011 *U.S. News & World Report* rankings, moving up four points from last year and elevating us into the top five nationally.

*U.S. News & World Report* released its 2011-2012 rankings of America's Best Children's Hospitals – Children's Hospital Colorado ranked 5th on the Best Children's Hospital's Honor Roll. Four of Children's specialty areas were among the country's top 10, including:  
4<sup>th</sup> for Pulmonology  
4<sup>th</sup> for Diabetes and Endocrinology  
5<sup>th</sup> for Gastroenterology  
10<sup>th</sup> for Cancer

*U.S. News & World Report* ranked the Department of Pediatrics Child Health Associate/Physician Assistant Program 11th in the country out of 148 programs. CHA/PA is the only physician assistant program with a pediatric emphasis.

The Department of Pediatrics ranked first among all medical school-based Departments of Pediatrics in NIH awards, securing more than \$39 million in peer-reviewed awards from the NIH during 2010.

The Dean's office recently announced the creation of the Bruce Wallace, PhD and Robin Deterding, MD Awards. These awards were named after Robin and Bruce, based upon their contributions in leading and developing the new medical school curriculum. Bruce and Robin led the huge effort to construct Phases 1 and 2 (Bruce) and Phases 3 and 4 (Robin). Beginning next year, awards will be presented to two medical students who excel in those phases.

The Section of Community Pediatrics created a non-profit organization to provide support services to assist private pediatric and family practices to enable and encourage them to provide a quality medical home for children covered by Medicaid and CHP+. This non-profit organization was recently awarded The Award for Excellence in the Health Care - given by the El Pomar Foundation to the Section of Community Pediatrics (and its non-profit organization, CCHAP) in 2010.

At the National Meeting of the Student Academy of the American Academy of Physician-Assistants (SAAAPA) the Student Society of PAs at the University of Colorado School of Medicine received a prestigious award, the Outstanding Master Student Society Award. This recognition is awarded to only one program each year.
