

## **Estimated Costs of Attendance – CHA/PA Program**

### **Current Tuition and Fees – 2011-2012 Academic Year\*\***

#### Tuition

The program is 137 credit hours, not evenly distributed by year or semester

- Resident Tuition: \$340/credit hour
- Nonresident Tuition: \$736/credit hour

*Students assessed non-resident tuition upon admission may apply for resident tuition the semester after residency is established. Most students are able to meet these requirements and be assessed resident tuition after the first year.*

*Tuition is determined yearly by the Regents and is subject to change.*

#### Additional UC Denver Fees

- Matriculation fee: \$140 – one-time, 1<sup>st</sup> year
- Academic Support Services fee: \$75 – each semester
- Activity fee - \$20 each – each year
- RTD College Pass Program - \$43.85 – each semester
- Health Insurance – student must have either UC Denver Student Health Insurance or a comparable plan - \$3,260 or \$2,553 per year; voluntary dental insurance \$353 per year, or a 12 month policy.

- Microbiology: \$35 (MPAS 5120)
- Psychosocial Aspects of Medicine: \$90 (MPAS 5202)
- Physical Diagnosis: \$440 (MPAS 5412)

- Surgical Clinical Preceptorship: \$55 (MPAS 6500)
- Emergency Medicine Lab fees: \$325 (MPAS 6512)
- Third Year Clinical Seminar: \$250 (MPAS 6980)
- Colorado Physician Health Plan: \$15 per year

#### Other expenses

- Books and equipment estimate  
1<sup>st</sup> year: \$2290  
2<sup>nd</sup> year: \$700
- Additional clinical expenses may include fingerprinting, additional health screenings, immunizations, urine drug testing, repeated criminal background checks, lab coats/goggles, or any other requirements of a specific clinical site. This is dependent on the clinical site.
- Criminal background checks repeated due to University background check policy.
- Graduation expenses for composite photo sitting and regalia
- Students are responsible for travel, housing, and living expenses related to clinical education and are required to complete at least one 3<sup>rd</sup> year clinical rotation in a rural area. Clinical education costs are variable depending on location and length, number, and location of the clinical rotation.
- Students are responsible for transportation and parking expenses

### **Admissions expenses – 2011-2012 Academic Year**

- Students offered admission to the program must submit a \$1000 confirmation deposit to hold their place. This deposit will be applied to the first semester of the program.
- Students admitted into the program must submit \$65 for a criminal background check.
- Students admitted to the program are responsible for the costs of immunization requirements and tuberculosis screening.
