# NATIONAL PREVALENCE

- One third of women in the US have experienced some form of interpersonal violence, including rape, physical violence, or stalking, during their lifetime
- One quarter of men have experienced rape, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner at some point in their lifetime
- Between 31 % to 50% transgender individuals experience interpersonal violence in their lifetime

PCA provides Free & Confidential\* resources for faculty, staff, and students at Anschutz.

## What we do:

- 24/7 confidential helpline (303-556-CALL)
- Academic advocacy
- Reporting/legal accompaniment
- Information and referrals
- Emotional & crisis support
- Victim's Rights Advocacy

## What we DON'T do

- Give legal advice/assistance
- Long term counseling
- Work with victims of crimes outside the scope of IPV
- "Check up" on people
- Hold total confidentiality/Act as "secret keepers"

\* Confidentiality held in accordance with CRS 13-90-107 (k) bars advocates from sharing any personal information except in the case of a written release of information or knowledge of *imminent* harm to themselves or someone else.
