This session is designed for those who have a basic understanding of iPad operation but want to learn more about how to implement it. The presenter will share different apps organized by category of intervention (apps for speech therapy, behavior, math, memory, etc). Participants will learn how to evaluate apps that they may be considering and the importance of matching features of the app to the needs of the child. The session will primarily focus on apps for children birth to twenty-one but obvious applications for adults with disabilities will exist. Participants will be encouraged to share their own implementation stories of successes and challenges in using the iPad.



Maureen Melonis, MNS, CCC-SLP, is Director of Assistive Technology Partners, Senior Instructor and AT Specialist. She serves as an AT consultant to the Colorado Department of Education, Exceptional Student Leadership Unit and is Principal Investigator for early intervention and AT services in the state.
