Volunteers with Chronic Kidney Disease needed for a Uric Acid Lowering Research Study

What is the purpose

- To understand the effect of lowering serum uric acid levels on vascular function in individuals with a chronic kidney disease by comparing the effects of
  1. Allopurinol therapy and
  2. Placebo

Who can participate?

- Individuals with moderate chronic kidney disease ( CKD stage III) with estimated glomerular filtration rates between 30-60 mL/min/1.73m<sup>2</sup>
- Elevated uric acid levels
- Age range: more than 18 years old
- Pregnant and lactating women are not eligible

What will you receive?

- A 3 month study drug ( either allopurinol or placebo)
- Assessment of serum uric acid levels and vascular function
