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Healthy Infants Fed Milk-Based Formulas with Different Fat Blends

Are you feeding your baby infant formula?

We are looking for infant formula fed babies to participate in a research study.

Study Purpose:

- To learn more about how calcium & fat are absorbed in healthy infant formula-fed babies
- To give babies two different milk-based infant formulas & see which formula is tolerated better
- To see which formula has the better fat and calcium absorption

- Will bring your baby to The Children's Hospital for a blood draw on Day 15 and Day 29 of study
