HIGH SCHOOL/COLLEGE CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

High School juniors and seniors above average academic abilities may apply to the University of Colorado Denver for courses which supplement (but do not replace) their high school programs. These must be courses not currently available at the student's high school. Courses taken at UC Denver will appear on a University of Colorado transcript and may affect the student's eligibility for admission to a degree program at the University of Colorado or other collegiate institutions. If admitted, credit for courses successfully completed may be applied toward an undergraduate degree.

Applicants wishing to apply for consideration as high school/college concurrent students must submit the following materials:

1. Completed Parent/Counselor/Principal Approval Form
2. UC Denver application for non-degree admission
3. \$25 non-refundable application fee.
4. Unofficial high school transcript
5. SAT or ACT scores (if available).

NOTE: High school/college concurrent students are admitted for one term at a time. A student wishing to enroll for classes at UC Denver in subsequent semesters must repeat steps one and two each semester. The application fee and transcript requirements will be waived after the first semester.

Application Deadlines:

Summer term: May 1
Fall term: July 22
Spring term: December 1
