

FRESHMEN

For academic advising, Arts and Media, Pre-Business, Pre-Engineering, and Undeclared/Undecided students in Liberal Arts and Sciences should contact the Academic Success and Advising Center located in the North Classroom (NC Room 2024), 303-352-3520. For most freshmen, academic advising is included as part of student orientation. You may register after paying your tuition deposit and receiving advisor approval.

Freshmen students who do not fall into one of the categories above should contact an Academic Advisor in their respective school or college (Business: 303-315-8100, Engineering: 303-556-4768, Liberal Arts: 303-556-2555, or Public Affairs: 303-315-2227). ALL STUDENTS

Students may register on or after their assigned time and after paying a tuition deposit and receiving advisor approval (if required). To register and view the Schedule of Courses, go to www.ucdenver.edu/UCDAccess.

All communication from the Financial Aid Office concerning your 2010-2011 financial aid will be through your UCD email account and the new UCDAccess Portal.

Before you are eligible to register for Fall 2010 and future semesters, you will need to pay a deposit of \$200.00 which will be applied to your tuition bill, unless waived by financial aid. To make your registration advance payment, please log into www.ucdenver.edu/UCDAccess.

Students may check their financial aid application, loan and award status on the Web at www.ucdenver.edu/UCDAccess. In this same location, you may check registration status, search for courses, register for classes, view/print your schedule, check your account balance and pay your bill, check your grades, view your unofficial transcript and order your transcript, change your address, view your email address, and check your COF eligibility.

If you have been admitted based on an unofficial transcript or had your application fee or other admission requirements temporarily waived, you will not be able to register for the next semester until those requirements have been submitted. Submit these items as quickly as possible. NOTE: New Freshmen: If you took a college course(s) while you were in high school, you need to provide an official transcript before you will be eligible to register for the next semester.

Books are available at the Auraria Bookstore (Tivoli, Lower level: 303-556-4286). Bring a copy of your current semester schedule of courses, which is available at www.ucdenver.edu/ACDAccess or from the Student Service Center (NC 1001).

To obtain your student ID, go to the Tivoli room 269 (303-556-8385). Bring a copy of your current semester schedule and a picture ID. New students are provided an ID at no charge. Stop by the Student Service Center, NC 1001, and get your schedule of classes stamped to receive a free ID.

E-mail is an official form of communication from the University of Colorado Denver. Faculty and administration expect that e-mails will be received and read in a timely fashion. Mailing addresses must be kept up-to-date with UC Denver.

The required email account for enrolled students is the one assigned to you by the University.
