

FRESHMEN

When we received your application for admission, we sent you your student ID number and your personal identification number (PIN). You will need this to register.

For advising, Arts and Media students, Pre-Business, Pre-Engineering, and Undeclared/Undecided students in Liberal Arts and Sciences should contact the Academic Success and Advising Center located in the North Classroom (NC Room 2024), 303-352-3520. You may register after paying your tuition deposit and receiving advisor approval.

Freshmen students who do not fall into one of the categories above must meet with an Academic Advisor in their respective school or college (Business: 303-315-8100, Engineering: 303-556-4768, Liberal Arts: 303-556-2555, or Public Affairs: 303-315-2227). You may register after receiving advisor approval and paying your tuition deposit.

TRANSFER

When we received your application for admission, we sent you your student ID number and your personal identification number (PIN). You will need this to register.

For advising, Pre-Business, Pre-Engineering, and Undeclared/Undeclared students should contact the Academic Success and Advising Center located in the North Classroom (NC Room 2024), 303-352-3520. You may register after paying your tuition deposit and receiving advisor approval.

Transfer students who do not fall into one of the categories above should contact an academic advisor in their respective school or college (Arts and Media: 303-556-2279, Business: 303-315-8100, Engineering: 303-556-4768, Liberal Arts: 303-556-2555, or Public Affairs: 303-315-2227). You may register after receiving advisor approval and paying your tuition deposit.

A transfer credit evaluation will be completed 7 to 10 working days after admission (if all **official** transcripts have been submitted from all colleges). Your advisor will tell you how these credits apply to your degree at the University of Colorado Denver.

GRADUATE & NON-DEGREE

When we received your application for admission, we sent you your student ID number and your personal identification number (PIN). You will need this to register.

If you wish to take graduate business courses as a non-degree student, contact the Graduate School of Business at 303-315-8200 for additional requirements.

ALL STUDENTS

Students may register on or after their assigned time and after paying a tuition deposit and receiving advisor approval. To register, go to www.ucdenver.edu/registrar.

Before you are eligible to register for Maymester 2010, Summer 2010 and future semesters, you will need to pay a deposit of \$200.00 which will be applied to your tuition bill. For more information, go to www.ucdenver.edu click on Tuition/Financing.

Students may check their financial aid application, loan and award status on the Web at www.ucdenver.edu/registrar. In this same location, you may check registration status, search for courses, register for classes, view/print your schedule, check your account balance and pay your bill, check your grades, view your unofficial transcript and order your transcript, change your PIN/address, view your email address, and check your COF eligibility.

If you have been admitted based on an unofficial transcript or had your application fee or other admission requirements temporarily waived, you will not be able to register for the next semester until those requirements have been submitted. Don't wait until the day you want to register to remember you still need to provide the required materials. **NOTE:** New Freshmen: If you took a college course(s) while you were in high school, you need to provide an official transcript before you will be eligible to register for the next semester.

Books are available at the Auraria Bookstore (Tivoli, Lower level: 303-556-4286). Bring a copy of your current semester schedule of courses, which is available from the Student Service Center (NC 1001).

To obtain your student ID, go to the Tivoli room 269 (303-556-8385). You need to have a copy of your current semester schedule of courses and a picture ID (driver's license or state I.D). New students to the University of Colorado Denver are provided an ID at no charge. You may stop by the Student Service Center, NC 1001, and get your schedule of classes stamped to enable you to receive a free ID.

E-mail is an official form of communication to enrolled students from the University of Colorado Denver. Faculty and administration expect that e-mails to students will be received and read in a timely fashion. It is the student's responsibility to keep their mailing address up-to-date with the University of Colorado Denver.

The required email account for enrolled students is the one assigned to you by the University.
