The Denver Transfer Initiative (DTI) is a federally funded Title V collaborative grant between the University of Colorado Denver and the Community College of Denver. The purpose of the grant is to help low income and/or minority students successfully transfer from CCD to UCD and earn a Bachelor degree.

The Title V grant that funds DTI was scheduled to end in September 2011; however, DTI's leadership requested an extension of the grant

from the Department of Education. The extension, which was granted on September 22, 2011 gives DTI the opportunity to remain on the Auraria Campus for another year. DTI will continue "business as usual" with case management, peer mentors, academic support, workshops, social events, and overall student support.
