1. Instructions

With the migration of our email to Office 365 the OIT Infrastructure team is enabling a policy that will automatically configure all Microsoft Outlook 2010/2013 clients in 'Cached Exchange Mode' to follow Microsoft's best practices. This will provide a much better experience when using the Outlook client.

If your Outlook client is already configured to use 'Cached Exchange Mode', this change will not impact you. You can adjust how much data is stored locally on your computer, by default cached mode will store up to one-year of email on your computer. In some cases this maybe too much depending on your device (tablets with small hard drives especially) and storage availability. To adjust this setting follow the steps below.

Step 1. Click the File tab
