



Number and Rate of Fatal Work Injuries U.S. Oil & Gas Extraction Industry, 2003-2016






GOAL

Consistency in oil and gas fatality reporting


Increase knowledge about occupational illness

O reported silicosis cases to date

1st data project: Workers Compensation Claims

- Created claims data definition, analysis plan
- Data request to state bureaus
- Key word search (phase 2)
- OSHA Oil and Gas Conference, Dec. 2018

Other successes



- OGE OSHA severe injury data for all states
- WY approval for public records sharing (with NIOSH)
- Interest in NIOSH OGE survey by two states
- Learning similarities across states (i.e. crash systems)
