<p>1. Quality of scholarly/creative activity: Is there evidence of original scholarly/creative activity (i.e. student scholarly/creative activity contribution)? Does the research project demonstrate quality methodology? Does the creative activity demonstrate innovativeness? 40 points maximum [0 (poor) – 20 (average) – 40 (excellent)]</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	
<p>2. Communication ability: Does the student effectively communicate the purpose, method, and outcomes of the research or creative activity? Scoring includes visual, text, and verbal dimensions. 15 points maximum [0 (poor) – 7.5(average) – 15(excellent)]</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	
<p>3. Visual Presentation: Is the poster a well-organized, concise presentation of complex material? Does the poster catch the reviewer’s eye and hold attention while conveying the key points of the project? 15 points maximum [0 (poor) – 7.5 (average) – 15 (excellent)]</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	
<p>4. Overall value of activity to student(s) learning. Did the activity result in a significant educational experience for the student(s)? 15 points maximum [0 (poor) – 7.5 (average) – 15 (excellent)]</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	
<p>5. Impact of the activity. Will the activity have a professional impact outside UCDenver, e.g., publication of article; presentation at a professional conference; exhibit; performance? 10 points maximum [0 (poor) – 5 (average) – 10 (excellent)]</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>	
<p>6. Extent of collaboration with faculty sponsor. Is there evidence of collaboration? Does the faculty mentor play a role in the scholarly activity? 5 points maximum [0 (excessive) – 2.5 (significant) – 5 (appropriate)]</p> <p><u>Comments:</u></p>
