NEW STUDENT CHECKLIST

- 1. ACCEPT YOUR OFFER OF ADMISSION**
Follow the link in your letter of admission to accept your offer to be a CU Denver student.
- 2. CLAIM YOUR CU DENVER ACCOUNT**
Gain access to your student portal and email account
- 3. SUBMIT IMMUNIZATION RECORDS**
In your welcome packet you received information on how and where to submit your immunization records. Please complete this before attending New Student Orientation. Contact the Auraria Health Center for more information.
- 4. FILE FAFSA FOR FINANCIAL AID**
Go to fafsa.gov to start the financial aid process. Questions? Contact the Financial Aid Office.
- 5. APPLY FOR HOUSING**
On campus housing provides students the opportunity to fully experience residential life at CU Denver. Click here to apply!
- 6. SIGN UP FOR NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION (NSO)**
New Student Orientation assists students with their transition to CU Denver.
- 7. MEET WITH ADVISING**
It is important to meet with an academic advisor prior to class registration. First year students will get to do this at NSO.
- 8. REGISTER FOR CLASSES**
After meeting with your advisor, you should be ready to register for your first semester of classes. Log in to your student portal to search and enroll. First year students will get to do this at NSO.
- 9. GET BOOKS AND ID**
The Tivoli Student Union is home to our campus bookstore and is where you can secure your student ID and RTD pass. Once you have a course schedule you can get both of these items.
- 10. PAY YOUR BILL**
Check your student portal to view and pay your tuition bill. If you are receiving financial aid, your aid will disburse beginning the start of the semester. Contact Financial Aid or the Bursar's office for financial aid or billing questions.
- 11. FORWARD FINAL TRANSCRIPTS**
CU Denver will need your final high school or college transcripts. Please submit these transcripts to the Office of Admissions.
- 12. CHECK DEGREE AUDIT**
Your degree audit shows your progress toward your degree. Your degree audit is available in your student portal.
