Register with Selective Service!

What is the requirement?

Colorado state law requires that **students who were assigned male at birth and are between the ages of 17 years, 9 months and 25 years old** must certify that they have registered with the U.S. Selective Service System before they are allowed to enroll in classes at a state-supported Institution ([Colorado Senate Bill 03-255](#)).

- If you are between the ages of 17 years, 9 months and 18 years, you must complete early registration.
- If you are between the ages of 18 and 26, even if you are a [conscientious objector](#), you must complete your registration (Colorado House Bill 1021, effective July 1, 1987).

What you need to do

To fulfill this requirement, two steps must be completed once you are admitted to CU Denver. **Failure to submit this form will result in a hold being placed on your account, preventing you from enrolling in classes.** [Conscientious objectors](#) are still required to register with the Selective Service System.

Step One: Register online with Selective Service

- Go to [Selective Service](#) website.
- Click Register, then Register Online.
- Complete and submit the form.

Step Two: Verify Your Registration in UCDAccess

- Log in to UCDAccess
- Under Registration/Records (top of page), click Selective Service Verification.
- Complete and submit the form.

Office of the Registrar staff will manually remove the hold from your account one business day after you complete step two.
