___ **Active your email account**—Your University email address is the required official address utilized for all University correspondence. I will begin using this after the first day of classes in August. All other organizations on campus most likely will begin utilizing it right away.

___ **Sign up for New Student Orientation**—You should attend New Student Orientation on Friday, August 19. You only need to attend in the morning as the afternoon session is for advising and you should all have been advised and registered by that time. You may also attend one of the earlier sessions in the summer, if you would like though it is NOT required, nor suggested you make the trip unless you have previous plans to do so.

___ **Finalize student housing lease (Campus Village Apartments - CVA), if required**—Denver Bound students are given priority on living with other Denver Bound students and living on the honor floor only if complying with the deadline. If you do not wish for this arrangement, please contact me. If you have already placed a request, it should be honored. If you have your own arrangements, please verify this with Campus Village and let me know who you have requested as a roommate so I can follow up. When talking with CVA let them know you are a Denver Bound Scholar. I will also remain in contact with them over the summer to verify all students required to live in CVA have approved leases. If you are a transfer student and wish to live in CVA, please let me know to include you on my list of students living there. Transfer students are not required to live on the freshmen floor. Exemptions to the University policy of living at CVA as nonresident freshmen are approved through Student Life, not CVA.

___ **Agreement to pay CVA with financial aid funds**—If you wish to have any financial aid funds to go toward your Campus Village lease after tuition and fees are paid to the University, please inform CVA and complete the proper paperwork set up during the lease process.

___ **Complete your Immunization record, if not yet completed**—Students are required to complete the proper immunizations, or request a waiver. Failure to comply can place a hold on your account and prevent you from registering for classes.

___ **Register for classes**—All freshmen and transfer students are required to receive advising before the registration hold can be lifted and you can register for classes. You should have received academic advising at the Denver Bound recruiting weekend, if you attended. concerns with the registration process, please contact me immediately. To search/register for classes, utilize your student portal (first screen shot below).

Financial Aid— Financial aid includes grants, loans, and all scholarships (including both Denver Bound and any additional outside scholarships. If you have applied for federal financial aid via FAFSA, you will receive a formal award notification soon via the University email address. You can also check the information via Student Portal (screen shot one below). When contacting the Financial Aid Office always identify yourself as an out-of-state Denver Bound Scholarship Scholar and request to speak with Charmaine Brown. Her contact email is charmaine.brown@ucdenver.edu.

Denver Bound Scholarship—The Denver Bound scholarship will be posted on the financial aid account by the middle of June. Your signed contract is verification you have the amount authorized per year.

Direct Deposit—In order to receive a refund owed after tuition and fees are paid via direct deposit into your bank account, set up the direct deposit over the summer —review the second/third screen shots of the student portal below.

Access your student portal—Go to the top of the University of Colorado Denver webpage <http://ucdenver.edu/Pages/UCDWelcomePage.aspx> and locate 'Portals' in the set of blue colored tabs just above the search bar, or directly at the address below—

1. Authorize Direct Deposit

I hereby authorize the University of Colorado to :

1. Deposit credit balances from my tuition and fee account via electronic transfer of funds to my account at the financial institution that I designate.
2. Credit my checking or savings account with these funds.
3. Initiate, if necessary, debit entries and adjustment for any credit entries in error to my account.

I understand that:

1. Once I have signed up for direct deposit, any future credit balance will automatically be deposited in my financial institution account. For degree-seeking students at the Boulder campus, this includes the required enrollment deposit (less any outstanding charges) which will be deposited approximately 4-6 weeks after graduation or separation.
2. This direct deposit authorization does NOT authorize the university to withdraw money from my account for tuition and fee charges.
3. The deposit will show on my financial institution account approximately two to three business days after the credit appears on my university tuition and fee account.
4. I should contact my financial institution to verify receipt of funds.
5. I acknowledge that the origination of direct deposit transaction to my account must comply with the provisions of U.S. law. I also understand that I cannot cancel this authorization through any third parties, including my financial institution, but must cancel this authorization by deleting my account using the following pages, or contacting my campus Bursar's Office in writing or e-mail.
6. Refunds reflect current activity on each campus's bursar account. I realize I may be assessed future charges if I change my schedule, enroll in a waitlisted class, or receive a financial aid adjustment. If I am enrolled at more than one campus, I understand I may have a separate bill that may still need to be paid.
