

# DISPLACED AURARIAN SCHOLARSHIP

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The Displaced Aurarian Scholarship is designed to provide funds for tuition and fees for undergraduate and graduate students who were residents of the Auraria neighborhood at the time the Auraria Campus was first built, between 1955 and 1973. The program also extends to the children and grandchildren of these residents.

To be eligible for this program, students must be Colorado residents and classified as degree-seeking by the UC Denver Office of Admissions. This program only covers tuition and fees for state-supported classes taught at the downtown campus (Auraria). Classes taught at other locations, including Anschutz Medical Campus, are not funded by the scholarship.

- Duration:** A total of 8 semesters, including summer semesters, at a minimum of half-time enrollment each semester (6 credits undergraduate, 3 credits graduate).
- Amount:** The student's share of in-state tuition and fees for regular, state-supported university classes taught at the downtown campus (Auraria). Classes not funded by the state or taught at other locations, including Anschutz Medical Campus, Extended Studies and Study Abroad are not covered by the scholarship.
- Verification of Eligibility:** All applicants must provide documentation proving residency for themselves, their parents or grandparents in the Auraria neighborhood between the years of 1955 and 1973. Birth certificates, school and church records, tax documents, newspaper articles, etc. may be used as verification.
- Application Process:** The application is available online at <http://www.ucdenver.edu/scholarships> . Students are encouraged to submit the scholarship application once they have been admitted to UC Denver. Recommended scholarship deadlines are May 30 for the upcoming fall semester and October 1 for the upcoming spring semester to receive maximum consideration.
- In addition, each applicant is strongly encouraged to submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the current and upcoming academic years.
- Undergraduate recipients of the Displaced Aurarian Scholarship must register for the College Opportunity Fund (COF) each semester.
- Selection Process:** The UC Denver Scholarship Resource Office will make all eligibility decisions and final award selections. Funding will be confirmed with the Financial Aid Office.
- Scholarship awards will be at the sole discretion of UC Denver and are offered on a first-come / first-served basis for students who maintain a GPA of 2.0 or higher, are not in default on a student loan, or owe funds to UC Denver. The number of recipients each year is limited by availability of funds. Applicants may be placed on a waiting list if funding is not sufficient.
