

UC DENVER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION

- ▲ Unless indicated otherwise, the Scholarship Application is available December 1, 2010 through April 1, 2011 5:00 pm Mountain Standard Time.
- ▲ Scholarships with automatic consideration do not require an additional application. They are awarded based upon the admission application or FAFSA data. Appropriate deadline dates must be followed.
- ▲ Scholarships marked with an * are available through the online application. The application can be accessed through the UCDAccess Portal.

 - Choose the "Student" tab
 - Click the "Student Center" link under "Financial Aid"
 - Click "Scholarship Application" in the Student Center
 - Click "Continue to Page Two"
 - If you meet the requirements of the scholarship, the application link will appear in your portal.
 - Please note: there is no "Submit" button; once you have saved your application, it will be uploaded into the application pool. You have until the deadline date to make changes to your application. You must complete all the requirements in order to complete your application.
- ▲ Some scholarships require additional information such as references, portfolios or special essays. Carefully read and follow the instructions for each scholarship.
- ▲ Scholarship marked with this symbol ‡ require a separate application. Refer to the Contact information provided under the deadline for additional information.
- ▲ All awards are contingent upon fund availability, meeting the applicable deadlines, and meeting all criteria at the time award selections are made. If this information changes, you may no longer qualify for the scholarship.
- ▲ The information published is accurate at the time of publication; however, changes may occur during the course of the academic year. For the most current information, please check the Scholarship Resource Office website at <http://www.ucdenver.edu/Scholarships>
- ▲ If a UC Denver scholarship deadline falls on a weekend or a holiday, the scholarship will be due the following business day.

- To be eligible for scholarships from the Office of Admission, you must be admitted to UC Denver Downtown Campus by February 1 (freshmen) or March 1 (transfer) for the summer or fall semester, and November 1 (all students) for the spring semester.
- To meet these deadlines, submit a complete application for admission at least one month prior to the deadline.
- Students are automatically considered for one award pending availability of funds.
- Students must be registered as a full-time student (12 or more credit hours).
- No separate scholarship application is required.
- After the deadline, additional awards are made if funds are available. Awards are made for fall and spring semesters only.
