

UC DENVER PARKING VIOLATION SAMPLES

Violations

- Parking overtime at a meter or limited time zone, including handicapped meters.
- Continuous feeding of a meter for a longer time than the maximum on the meter.
- Parking over the yellow line.
- Taking up more than one parking space.
- Parking without a valid permit in a designated zone, or in the wrong zone for permit.
- Parking in areas reserved for patients or visitors.
- Parking in No Parking areas.
- Parking in Emergency Room Ambulance areas.
- Obstructing a driveway, walkway, service drive, fire lane or trash receptacle.
- Failing to display permit in proper location.
- Storing personal vehicles in UC Denver facilities.
- Unauthorized use of loading zone, over 20 minute limit.
- Parking in handicapped area without valid State of Colorado permit.
- Driving on sidewalk or service drive (except for emergency vehicles).
- Misusing or altering parking permits or entry cards.
- Driving over a lawn or sidewalk or otherwise illegally entering/exiting a parking facility.
- Damaging UC Denver revenue control equipment, including breaking gate arms.
- Failure to pay parking fees.
- Tampering with any revenue control device, such as a gate, card reader, etc.
- Failure to obey traffic signage or control devices.
- Failure to obey the directions of a police officer, security guard or parking office.
