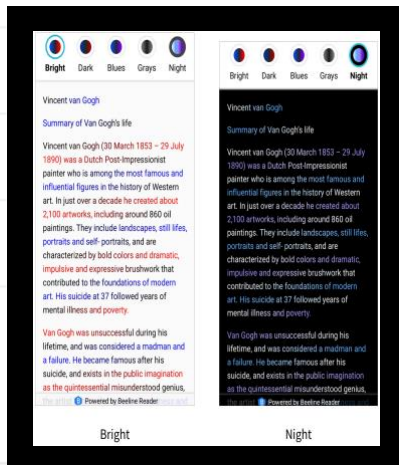

MP3 version for listening
-  **BeeLine Reader**
Enhanced version for easier and faster on-screen reading

- HTML Format**
- Great for reading on any electronic device
 - Can adjust text, font, background color
 - Can search within text



- BeeLine Reader**
- Color gradient increases reading speed, visual tracking, focus and helps tired eyes



- Immersive Reader**
- Provides audio
 - Text preferences
 - Grammar highlighting
 - Line focus
 - Picture dictionary
