

Colorado Medicaid Enrollment Application Instructions

Colorado Medicaid enrollment is required for all CU GME trainees. The only exception is if you have a dual instructor-fellow appointment and will be billing through CU Medicine. In that case you will be automatically enrolled by CU Medicine and no documentation needs to be obtained or uploaded to MedHub. If you are unsure if this applies to you, confirm with your [program coordinator](#) before moving forward with enrollment.

Step 1: Confirm Existing “Ordering, Prescribing, Referring” Enrollment - This step only applies to those who have previously trained in Colorado. All others should proceed to Step 2.

Confirm if you are already enrolled in Colorado Medicaid as an “Ordering, Prescribing, Referring” enrollment type by [logging in to Health First Colorado](#). If you are enrolled, a new application does not need to be submitted. Simply save a screenshot of your enrollment status and upload to MedHub.

NOTE: If you are already enrolled as a provider for moonlighting you do not need to re-enroll as an “Ordering, Prescribing, Referring”. Simply save a screenshot of your enrollment status and upload to MedHub.

Step 2: Complete Online Enrollment Application

Go to [Health First Colorado’s website](#) → Select Enrollment Application → Continue.

As you are completing the application, please **carefully reference the instructions provided below for each section**. If the application is not filled out correctly, it will be rejected by Health First Colorado. If you are unsure about any of the instructions provided, please contact CU Medicine at aceproviderenrollment@cumedicine.us BEFORE submitting your application.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you choose the **“Finish Later”** option to save your progress on the application and return at another time, **you must keep a record of your Tracking ID and Tax ID (SSN)**. You will need this information to resume the application and may need to start over completely if you lose it. When selecting “Finish Later”, that information should appear on your webpage for you to copy and save for future reference. To resume the application, choose the “Resume Enrollment” option on the [Health First Colorado’s website](#).

- NPI: Enter NPI number

- Taxonomy:
 - Ensure there is only one taxonomy code associated with your NPI number. If there are more than one, your application will be rejected.
 - ***Ensure the taxonomy code associated with your NPI number matches that listed in this application.** If it does not, your application will be rejected.
 - If you have a Training License (TL.), the taxonomy code associated with your NPI number and listed on this application **MUST** be **390200000X (Student in an Organized Health Care Education/Training Program)**.
 - If you have a Full License (DR.), you should list the same taxonomy code that is associated with your NPI number. This may be 390200000X (Student in an Organized Health Care Education/Training Program) or another code. Whatever code you list, **make sure it matches the code associated with your NPI.**
 - You can [verify your NPI taxonomy code here](#) and [update it via the instructions provided on the NPPES website](#) (if necessary). If you do update your NPI taxonomy, do not submit this application until you have received confirmation of the update from NPPES.

Provider Addresses

The service location name and address generally is the site where members obtain services and is either owned or rented by the provider. This location should be where supporting documentation related to claims is maintained.

The service location address must be a physical location. A post office box is not a valid service location address.

The service location address must include an office phone number and at least one email address. It is desired that the service location address provide a fax phone number.

- List the same address for **Billing** location
 - Select COPY under Action column for Service Location → OK
 - Select the copied address as the Billing Address
 - Email and Phone: Same as Service Location (CU email and program phone)
 - Pay To Name: Enter your name
 - Click **Add**
- Add the **Mailing** location (program office address)
 - Click on the + symbol, enter program address (obtain from your [program coordinator](#))
 - Email and Phone: Same as Service Location (CU email and program phone)
 - Mail To Name: Enter your name
 - Click **Add**

Provider Addresses

The provider addresses identify the location where a provider renders services, as well as locations that are used for billing and payment. At least one address must be selected as the primary address.

All Providers must enter a Service Location, Billing, and Mailing address. **Primary hospital address**

- Colorado Medical License (DORA)
 - Retrieve and print a copy of your license information from the [DORA License Lookup](#) tool → Printable View
 - Attach document to your application by selecting Browse, Navigate to the attachment, and select document.

- The attachment type is “DORA”
- Click **Add**
- GME Malpractice Letter
 - Retrieve and save a copy of your malpractice letter ([MedHub homepage](#) → Review Records→ Malpractice Confirmation 2020 (Shared Files section))
 - Attach document to your application by clicking the +to add another document, selecting Browse, Navigate to the attachment, and select.
 - The attachment type if “Proof of Malpractice/Liability”
 - Click **Add**

Terms of Agreement

- Click on the Provider Participation Agreement, which will open a new page
- Navigate back to the enrollment application
- Accept, sign, select “Review”, and Submit
- Print/save a copy for your records (you will need your **Tax ID** and **tracking number** to track enrollment status and/or return to finish the application at a later date)

Step 3: Confirm Application Approval

- You will receive an approval letter from Health First Colorado via email once your application is approved. Application processing can take up to 10 business days.
- You can track your application status via the [Health First Colorado Provider Enrollment – Status Tool](#). If you have additional questions about the status of your application, contact Health First Colorado at 1-844-235-2387 (requires name, SSN, NPI).
- If errors are identified in your application, you will receive details from Health First Colorado via email regarding necessary corrections and next steps.

NOTE: Make sure to reattach your CO Medical License and Malpractice Letter documents before resubmitting your application.

Step 4: Upload Proof of Enrollment to MedHub

Once your application is approved, you will need to upload proof of enrollment to your MedHub onboarding package. Acceptable forms of documentation include any of the following:

- Official approval letter from Health First Colorado (sent via email) - preferred
- A screenshot of your “approved” status within the Health First Colorado system. Screenshot must include your name, enrollment type (Ordering, Prescribing, Referring), and enrollment “approved” status.
- A screenshot of your “approved” status as listed in the [Health First Colorado Provider Enrollment – Status Tool](#). Screenshot must include your name, enrollment type (Ordering, Prescribing, Referring), and enrollment “approved” status.
