Agenda Notes:

1. Kenny Wolf and Jeff Franklin – team working on four-year assessment of status of learning objectives and outcomes as they relate to the core curriculum.
 - A. Nine teams of faculty already working to identify comprehensive list of learning outcomes and rubrics for each area of the core.
 - B. Future of project – tentatively to require all core courses to have learning outcomes and assessment.
 - C. Goal for end of this year – solidify learning outcomes, rubrics, and assessment tools in all nine faculty teams.
 - D. Unsure how this assessment team articulates with the goals and duties of CCOC but would clearly aid the CCOC in the assessment of courses for Core requirements.
2. How do we handle international students who move to the US during high school?
 - A. Already decided that international students who *graduate* from high school will receive IP proficiency (i.e., can check the IP box) but will not receive IP credit.
 - B. An advisor brought this issue up because it's an "unclear" policy.
 - C. ACTION – send out memo to advising offices to clarify this issue; post on CCOC website.
3. Students with prior bachelor's degrees
 - A. No state policy right now about how this articulates with core at university.
 - i. May want to invite advising offices to participate in this discussion, to share their knowledge about advising students in this situation.
