



Accessing Transfer Evaluation

To access your transfer evaluation, go to **Degree Audit Tools** through your student portal.



Click on **Degree Audit**



Once in degree audit tools, click on **Transfer Evaluations**

Courses from previous institutions can transfer in 3 different ways:

- Direct equivalency with CU Denver course code
- DEPT#999TC - The course needs further evaluation from faculty. It may meet core, major elective, or general elective requirements. **If you would like a TC course evaluated, please meet with your advisor and bring a detailed syllabus/course description to start the process.**
- DEPT#999AE - This has been evaluated by faculty, but there is not a CU Denver equivalent. It may meet core, major, major elective, or general elective requirements based on content.

- Quarter hour credits submitted for transfer will be converted to semester hours. 1 quarter hour = 0.67 semester hours
- Courses transferring in with more credit hours than CU Denver equivalent course will be awarded elective hours for excess and appear as DEPT#999AE
