

CU Denver’s selection criteria for the Developmental Education policy is based on two assessments.

1. Primary Assessment

- a. Math sub-score below 19 ACT or 500 SAT
- b. English sub-score below 18 ACT or 470 SAT

2. Secondary Assessment

- a. Below 3.25 for both areas (for Math & English) – see table.

Mathematics	ACT/SAT Math sub-score below 19 ACT/500 SAT <u>AND</u> high school GPA below 3.25
English	ACT/SAT English sub-score below 18 ACT/470 SAT <u>AND</u> high school GPA below 3.25

OPTIONS FOR MEETING DEVELOPMENAL ED. REQUIREMENTS

Math Options:

- 1. If major requires Math 1010, and student is below assessments:
Take Math 1010 + 1 credit workshop: Math 1011
OR
Take Mat 050 at community college to prep for Math 1010
- 2. If major requires Math 2830:
Take Math 2830 + 1 credit workshop: Math 2831. *NOTE: Math 2831 will be available in spring 2019*
- 3. If major requires Math 1070, 1110, 1120, 1130:
Take Mat 055 through community college as preparation

English Options:

- Take English 1020 and complete with C- or better
- OR
- Take remedial English at community college
