The CU Anschutz Disability Resources and Services Office has virtual hours from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. Monday – Friday. We will be working with you and your faculty to continue supporting your specific accommodations in an online format. The office at the Strauss Health Sciences Library including the Testing Center will be closed with rare exceptions that require special permission.
