CRA Certification

Why do it?

- ▶ Earning the designation of Certified Research Administrator® (CRA®), Certified Pre-Award Research Administrator (CPRA®), or Certified Financial Research Administrator (CFRA) means that an individual has met the requirements of the Research Administrators Certification Council's (RACC) eligibility requirements and has demonstrated a level of knowledge necessary for a person to be a professional research or sponsored programs administrator.
- ▶ WHY SHOULD I BECOME CERTIFIED? Benefits Include:
 - Professional recognition
 - Personal Satisfaction
 - An indicator of expertise
 - Increased opportunities for employment
 - Advancement opportunities
 - Increased credibility with clients
 - Serve as a role model to others

August 14-28, 2021, Application Deadline: 7/14/2021 by 11:59pm EST

▶ Certified Financial Research Administrator

March 6-20, 2021, Application Deadline: 2/3/2021 by 11:59pm EST

September 11-25, 2021, Application Deadline: 8/11/2021 by 11:59 EST

- ▶ At the end of each five-year period, recertification will be required in order to continue to use the CRA®, CPRA®, and CFRA designation.
