ISSS Fall 2025 Arrival Guide for International Students

CU Anschutz

CU Anschutz students should speak with their department about late arrival. The
department will need to submit a new Immigration Document Creation Request to
confirm your new start date.

CU Denver

- We strongly recommend that international students new to CU Denver arrive by Sunday, August 10 for Welcome Week. Participating in Welcome Week activities will help you transition to campus and set you up for success.
- If you cannot arrive in time for Welcome Week, plan to arrive by Monday, August 18 for the start of classes. This will get your first semester at CU Denver off to a solid academic start.
- Monday, August 25 is one week after classes begin. Missing a full week of classes may
 negatively impact your learning and your grade. All course waitlists are eliminated on
 August 25 and students will be charged a fee for adding/dropping classes after this
 date. Arriving after August 25, 2025 will require communication with your academic
 program and instructors to ensure that you will be able to enroll full-time, which is
 required to maintain F-1 status.
- Wednesday, September 3* is "census day" and is the absolute last date that a student should arrive for Fall 2025. If you cannot arrive in Denver by September 3, you will need to defer your attendance to a future term.
 - *Exception: Graduate students starting the 2nd 8-week term could potentially arrive later. Please consult with your academic advisor or program to explore if this is a viable option for you.
