

ECE Credential Evaluations FAQs

Documentation Requirements

What documents do I need to submit to ECE?

Please check the [ECE Documentation Requirements](#) page.

ECE requires official transcripts, but I cannot get my official transcripts. What should I do?

Please contact CU Denver International Admissions at intldocuments@ucdenver.edu.

My institution does not issue transcripts in English. Do I need to submit English translations?

English translations are required for all documents issued in a language other than English. Please check the [ECE Documentation Requirements/Questions about Translations of Educational Documents](#) page and contact ECE if you have any questions.

Do I have to submit my transcripts to ECE or CU Denver when I apply to CU Denver?

Please send your transcripts for institutions located outside the United States to ECE; DO NOT send them to CU Denver. If you have attended any institutions located inside the United States, you must send those transcripts to CU Denver.

My courses and/or degree program are in progress. Can I submit my in-progress transcripts to ECE?

Yes. You can submit your in-progress transcript to ECE. However, once you are fully admitted to CU Denver, you will need to provide your official final transcript and degree certificate to CU Denver International Admissions during your first semester of study at CU Denver.

Please schedule a [document verification appointment](#) before bringing your official final transcript(s) and degree certificate(s) to International Admissions.

I had an ECE evaluation for my in-progress coursework when I applied to CU Denver, and now I have finished my degree program. Do I have to get an additional ECE evaluation for the final coursework/degree?

No. You don't need to get an additional ECE evaluation for your final coursework. You just need to provide your official final transcript with degree completion information to CU Denver International Admissions. Please schedule a [document verification appointment](#) before bringing your official final transcript(s) and degree certificate(s) to International Admissions.

I already sent my transcript to CU Denver when I submitted my application. Do I need to submit my transcript to ECE as well?

Yes. You will need to send your official transcript to ECE for their evaluation.

ECE Evaluation Requirements

Do you accept WES evaluation reports or any other third-party evaluations?

For Denver campus programs: No. We only accept the ECE course by course evaluation. We DO NOT accept evaluations from any other company or organization. For Anschutz campus programs: Please contact your department/program for more information.

I see that ECE provides many different types of evaluation reports. Which type of evaluation report does CU Denver accept?

We only accept ECE Course by Course evaluations. This is the only report type available through the CU Denver landing page.

I am applying for an undergraduate program. Do I need an ECE evaluation?

No. You do not need an ECE evaluation to apply for our undergraduate programs.

Does the non-degree study require an ECE evaluation?

It depends. If it is purely a non-degree program, ECE evaluation will not be required. If it is a certificate program, ECE evaluation will be required. Please contact CU Denver International Admissions if you have any questions regarding the ECE evaluation requirement for certificate programs.

I already have an ECE Course by Course evaluation report that I used when I applied for another institution. Can I use it to apply to CU Denver?

Yes. You can use the same report. Please contact ECE and ask them to deliver your course by course report to CU Denver. Please note that we prefer to receive it electronically with your transcript/translation copies. ECE may charge you a destination fee.

I have study abroad credits. Do I need an ECE evaluation?

You do not need to provide an ECE evaluation for study abroad credits earned as part of a US degree program and reported on a US transcript.

ECE Course By Course Evaluation

How long does it take ECE to complete a report?

Due to current high volume, order processing may up to 10 business days from the date ECE receives all required information. Processing time can vary and does not include delivery time, weekends, or holidays. If you have a deadline, ECE offers a 5 Business Day Rush Service (\$80) and delivery options. How much does a credential evaluation cost?

The cost to have your transcript evaluated, reported, and sent to CU Denver is \$195 plus a delivery fee. You can send additional copies to other universities for \$30 each, and you can guarantee a 5-day turnaround time by paying an additional rush fee. Please contact ECE for more information.

Does ECE recognize 3-year bachelor degrees from India as comparable to US bachelor degrees?

No. ECE considers 3-year degrees from India to be comparable to 3 years of undergraduate study in the US. However, CU Denver treats Indian 3-year bachelor degrees as qualifying credentials for admission to graduate degree programs.

How do I apply for the ECE evaluation?

After you submit your admission application to CU Denver, we will send you an email containing a link to the specific CU Denver landing page where you can order your ECE evaluation. When you order through the CU Denver page, ECE will waive the \$30 destination fee to send your report to CU Denver.

How does CU Denver waive the application fee?

If you are required to provide an ECE evaluation, our application system will automatically waive your application fee. If you have questions or encounter any trouble, please contact us at intldocuments@ucdenver.edu. Please see the table below for an explanation of your fees.

Is it possible to waive the ECE evaluation fees?

If the cost of an ECE evaluation is prohibitive, please contact us at intldocuments@ucdenver.edu.

I applied to CU Denver in a previous term and my credentials were evaluated by International Admissions. Do I need to provide an ECE evaluation?

Yes. The ECE evaluation requirement applies to applications submitted on or after July 1, 2022. Your new application is subject to the new policy.

I have already been admitted to CU Denver in fall 2022, but I want to defer my admission to spring 2023. Do I need to provide an ECE evaluation?

No.

I applied for fall 2022 and I have not yet received a decision. I want to defer my application to spring 2023. Do I need to provide an ECE evaluation?

The answer depends on when you submitted your application. The ECE evaluation requirement applies to applications submitted on or after July 1, 2022.
