Additional Notes:

XMBA, XMHA, GEMM promote a fixed cost of the program. XMBA and XMHA students are billed a flat rate. GEMM students are billed a flat rate, plus the Info Tech and SIS fees, which add up to the promoted fixed cost.

Programs operating on both Denver and Anschutz campuses will either be charged by a term active programplan associated with a campus OR will arrange a revenue transfer by memorandum of understanding.

Any graduate student who is not registered during the term but taking comprehensive examinations must register in a "candidate for degree" plan and pay one credit hour of tuition plus non credit only fees [3].
