

**Strauss Health Science Library Guidelines**  
**Stay At Home Level (Red)**  
**Effective: November 9, 2020**

Badge accessible hours for the library will be 7:00 am – 9:00 pm seven days a week.

From 7:00 am – 9:00 pm seven days a week there will be a Community Ambassador at the entry door.

**Social distancing** – library users must remain 6 ft. from others at all times.

- Locations where this is challenging are specifically signed such as elevators and restrooms.
- Masks must be worn in all public spaces of the library building.

**Study Spaces** – there will be limited study space available in the library at the Stay At Home Level (Red)

- Rooms
  - There are 65 rooms with doors that must be closed.
  - All rooms, no matter the size, have a maximum occupancy of 1 person.
  - Masks must be worn in rooms at all times
  - Eating and drinking is allowed after 30 minutes in the room.
  - Rooms and workspaces must be cleaned when one starts work and when they leave for the day.
- Computers
  - There are four computers on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor with specialized statistical software.
  - Masks must be worn at all times at these locations.
  - Eating is not allowed at these locations.
  - Masks can be removed briefly to take a drink.
  - Rooms and workspaces must be cleaned when one starts work and when they leave for the day.

**Reservations**

- Users are required to make reservations before coming to the library to ensure space is available. That information can be found at <https://library.cuanschutz.edu/>
- Room reservations are held for 30 minutes past the start time and then forfeited.
- Community Ambassadors will be checking reservations upon entry to the library building. If a user does not have a reservation, Community Ambassadors will assist them with making one upon entry to the building if there is space available. If no study spaces are available, users will be unable to stay in the library building.
