

Nicknamed the "Mile High City", its official elevation is exactly one mile (5,280 feet or 1,609 meters) above sea level. CU Denver is located on the Auraria Campus, in the LoDo neighborhood. Sports venues, museums, restaurants, coffee shops, and bicycling paths are steps away. - Proof of English Language Proficiency (see below)
- SAT/ACT Score: Optional. SAT/ACT scores are not required, but can be submitted to help strengthen your application.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

You must provide proof of English language proficiency (ELP) in order to be considered for full admission. Undergraduate applicants (except Nursing) will be considered for *conditional admission* if they apply without adequate proof of ELP.
