SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL PLANNING

CU Denver offers a variety of financial aid and scholarship opportunities for international undergraduate students. We are committed to supporting your long-term academic and personal success at CU Denver, including your financial wellbeing.

International Admissions offers automatic merit-based scholarships worth up to \$10,000 per year. Additionally, international students can apply for further merit scholarships from International Admissions worth up to \$8,000 per year, as well as program-specific and external scholarships. Scholarships can be combined, along with employment opportunities and other financial resources, to contribute to the cost of attendance.

You must provide proof of English language proficiency (ELP) in order to be considered for full admission. Undergraduate applicants (except Nursing) will be considered for *conditional admission* if they apply without adequate proof of ELP.
