NOTES

- *Must be completed with C-/1.7 or better.
- **Must be completed with C/2.0 or better. "C-" or less will not fulfill the requirement.
- † Students must enroll in corresponding levels of Theory, Ear Training, and Piano together during the same semester. Students enrolled in Applied Music must also enroll in General Recital and Ensemble.

GENERAL NOTES:

- All upper division (3000/4000 level) Music courses must be taken at CU Denver unless otherwise approved by department.
- Students must complete a minimum of 120 total credits and must maintain at least a 2.0 University of Colorado cumulative GPA.
- Those placing out of Theory, Ear Training, Piano, or 1000/2000 level Applied Music courses must substitute other Music credit, as approved by department.
- At least 30 total credits must be completed in residency at CU Denver.
- Students must abide by all published prerequisites and corequisites, including minimum grades.
- CAM policy states that students who miss the first two class sessions of any CAM course can be administratively dropped. Likewise, students may not be permitted to add any CAM course if they have missed the first two class sessions.
- Students must apply to graduate. Consult the online academic calendar for deadlines.
- Consult the the CAM website, the CU Denver catalog and website, and the MEIS Student Handbook for complete requirements and policies.
