Steps to Becoming a Colorado Early Intervention Assistive Technology Consultant

1. Review the Early Intervention [Assistive Technology Consultant Guidelines](#) and [FAQ](#) for clarification on the roles and responsibilities of the position.
2. Complete the [AT Consultant Profile](#) and set up a time to go over it with the program manager at the CCB(s) you work with to determine how they utilize AT consultants. This can include in-house providers or contract providers. AT consultant roles and utilization can vary between CCB's. You can also contact at EIATCIDE@ucdenver.edu if you have questions or would like to discuss the position.
3. Either have attended the November, 2016 statewide live training in person or completed the online module.
4. [Contact Ashley Barker](#) at CIDE to create a login for the online training.
5. Complete the 4 online training modules for [Assistive Technology in Early Intervention](#) and upload your certificate of completion to the [EI Colorado website provider portal](#).
6. [Contact Ashley Barker](#) at CIDE to let her know you have completed the trainings and are ready for [Loan Library](#) access. You will receive the loan library agreement which needs to be signed by you and your CCB program manager. A loan library account will be created for you. More detailed info on setting up an account with the loan library can be found in the [FAQ](#) document.
7. Let your CCB team know you're an AT Consultant and that you can function in the capacity agreed upon by you and your program manager.
