- Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) – **Cost for online paid to AHA:** \$132.00
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) - **Cost for online paid to AHA:** \$132.00
- Basic Life Support (BLS)- **Cost for online paid to AHA:** \$28.50

The **second step** is taking the skills verification portion of the course at the Crash Conference.

**BLS Skills** 10am-11am **Cost of Skills paid to HEN** \$50

**ACLS Skills** 11:15am-12:30pm **Cost of Skills paid to HEN** \$150

**PALS Skills** 12:45-2pm **Cost of Skills paid to HEN** \$150

**ACLS:** The AHA Heartcode online program provides interactive scenario's of ACLS management. There are 10 case scenarios and generally takes between 6-8 hours to complete the program. The written exam is also provided online. Upon arrival at the skill verification in Vail, the participant will show proof of completion by presenting the AHA completion certificate to the instructor. .

**ACLS Skills cost is \$150 (11:15am-12:30pm) and include:**

- 3 cycles of adult BLS (30:2 compression to ventilation ratio)
- Mega-code/technology/rhythm review

AHA card & 13 CME will be awarded after completion of the above.

**BLS:** HeartCode BLS uses the latest eSimulation technology to enable students to assess and treat patients in virtual healthcare settings. Utilizing a variety of eLearning assets such as dramatizations, eSimulations, animations, self-directed learning, and interactive activities, this course teaches BLS knowledge and skills. This method of learning provides training consistency, adaptability to different learning styles, and flexibility for the student's and employer's time. Students can work at their own pace applying their knowledge to real-time decision making and skills development. Blended training also supports the need for hands-on learning of psychomotor skills. Debriefings and coaching are provided immediately after each simulation. Generally takes about 1.75 hours to complete. Upon arrival at the skill verification in Vail, the participant will show proof of completion by presenting the AHA completion certificate to the instructor.

**BLS Skills cost is \$50 (10:00pm-11:00am)**

AHA card & 1.75 CME will be awarded after completion of the above

**PALS:** The AHA Heart Code online program provides interactive scenario's of PALS management. There are 10 case scenarios and generally takes between 6-8 hours to complete the program. The final exam is provided online. Upon arrival at the skill verification in Vail, the participant will show proof of completion by presenting the AHA completion certificate to the instructor.

**PALS Skills cost is \$150 (12:45pm-2:00pm) and include:**

- 3 cycles of infant & child BLS
- IO and shock discussion
- Mega-code/technology/rhythm review

AHA card & 12 CME will be awarded after completion of the above.
