He went above and beyond in providing care for our family member, Alfredo Aceves, whom was admitted on 1/14 with an embolic stroke. After spending 4 hours in the procedure room with Alfredo, Dr. David Case thoughtfully sat down with our entire family and explained everything. Dr. Case patiently answered all of our questions and showed us pictures of the thrombectomy (i.e. the procedure to remove the embolus or blood clot). He was thoughtful and detailed, and we have been very appreciative of his excellent bedside manners.

About Alfredo Aceves: Our grandfather, Alfredo Aceves (born 9/16/1919), is 99 years old and his goal is to reach 100 years of age and because of Dr. David Case's care, this may be possible. Alfredo has always been an incredible grandfather to his 5 children, 19 grandchildren, 41 great grandchildren, 21 great great grandchildren, and 12 great great great grandchildren 😊

Until the age of 97, Alfredo Aceves would go to second hand stores and purchase broken assistive devices (i.e. wheelchairs, walkers, canes) and then fix them and send them to third world countries for poor disabled people.
