
ACCORDS Distinguished Lecturer Martha Sajatovic, MD

Dr. Sajatovic is Professor of Psychiatry and of Neurology at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine in Cleveland, Ohio. She is a researcher, educator, and clinician who has devoted herself to the study and treatment of traditionally hard-to treat populations with psychiatric and neurological disorders. Dr. Sajatovic holds the Willard Brown Chair in Neurological Outcomes at University Hospitals Case Medical Center/Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine. Dr. Sajatovic's research interests have focused on the management of chronic illnesses, particularly those that affect the brain and psychological processes.
