The Hemophilia and Thrombosis Center at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus is hosting a virtual and online EEMpact Parenting program to help its parents and families through these difficult times.

EEMpact Parenting is a program uniquely designed for parents of children with serious medical diagnoses and conditions. The program -

- Teaches parenting attitudes, knowledge, beliefs, and behaviors
- Encourages parent personal awareness
- Improves family health, viability, engagement, and interaction
- Connects parents with other parents and reduces the feeling of isolation
- Improves relationships between the parent-child-clinical/treatment team

The EEMpact program will include –

- Online videos and educational content; about 30 minutes each week
- Weekly 1-hour facilitated Zoom discussions on Thursday evenings from 7-8P MT
- Hard copy Parent Handbook and Materials

Program will run from September 14 thru November 19, 2020; first program Zoom will be on September 17, 2020

Requirements

- Parent of an infant or young child (ages 12 and under) with a bleeding disorder residing in Colorado
- Access to the internet and a computer or tablet with camera
